SUBJECT: General Obligations and Duties

PURPOSE: The purpose of this standard is to define the general duties not otherwise addressed in departmental SOP's, rules, or guidelines, that are to be performed by members of the Central Joint Fire District.

SCOPE: This standard shall apply all active members of the department.

ENFORCEMENT: The Fire Chief shall be responsible for the enforcement of this standard, for the protection of life and property, and the good of the department.

APPLICATION:

- 1) Protect the lives and property of any persons living in or transiting the geographical area serviced by the Central Joint Fire District.
- 2) All members addressed by this standard shall participate in all required training to the best of their ability.
- 3) It shall be the responsibility of all members addressed by this standard to be aware of and understand the meaning of all SOP's, rules, or guidelines, adopted by the Central Joint Fire District.
- 4) All non-essential personnel shall keep out of the fire structure.
- 5) Drivers shall be responsible for putting his or her apparatus back into a serviceable condition.
- 6) All members shall have the responsibility of keeping the Central Joint Fire District appraised of current address of residence as well as current phone numbers for said residence.
FAILURE TO PROVIDE CURRENT ADDRESS AND PHONE NUMBER OF STATED PLACE OF RESIDENCE SHALL RESULT IN DISCIPLINARY ACTION.
- 7) All members shall have the responsibility of keeping the Central Joint Fire District appraised of the serviceability of any and all equipment under his or her supervision.

8) All members shall have the responsibility of keeping the Central Joint Fire District appraised of his or her current physical and/or mental condition. Any change in physical and/or mental condition shall be promptly reported to the Fire Chief for consideration and possible action.
