**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this standard is to define the process by which departmental personnel may be approved to teach drills in which they have expertise.

**SCOPE:** This standard applies to all members of the Central Joint Fire District who are conducting training for the department.

**ENFORCEMENT:** Enforcement of this standard rests with the Training Officer and Fire Chief.

**APPLICATION:**

### 143B.1 Certified Public Safety Service Instructors

Only Instructors certified by the Ohio State Department of Emergency Medical Services may conduct or otherwise organize training for this department.

Only Instructors certified by the Ohio State Department of Emergency Medical Services may be appointed as Training Officer for this department.

### 143B.2 Assistant Instructors

Anyone may conduct a drill as long as they are approved by the training officer and have expertise in the area in which training is to be conducted. Such instructors will be known as "Assistant Instructors".

### 143B.3 General

"In house" training will not be conducted or recognized as being part of the official training program of this department unless the above criteria has been complied with.

Additional training in the area of effective teaching techniques may be required. "Instructional Techniques for Company Officers" or an equivalent program is a strongly suggested prerequisite for persons wanting to conduct training for the department.
