PURPOSE: The purpose of this standard is to define the types of training persons classified as probationary firefighters are to complete during their probationary period.

SCOPE: The standard applies to all probationary firefighters.

ENFORCEMENT: The responsibility for adherence and enforcement of this standard shall be with the Training Officer and ultimately the Chief.

APPLICATION:

- 210.1 All Probationary Firefighters shall pass the State Basic Volunteer Firefighter 36 hour course within one (1) year of appointment to the department, as required by the Ohio Revised Code.
- 210.2 All probationary firefighters shall complete the minimum level of hazardous material training consisting of the First Responder Awareness and Operation level, as defined in SOP 260, and as required by Federal and State regulations. This shall be completed within one (1) year of appointment to the department.
- 210.3 All probationary firefighters shall complete an Emergency Vehicle Driving course before being removed from probationary status.
- 210.4 After completion of drivers training probationary firefighter may operate apparatus under NON EMERGENCY conditions. Probationary firefighter will not be allowed to drive under Emergency conditions until he/she has been approved by the Chief or Training Officer.
- 210.5 All probationary members responding to an emergency incident shall properly equip themselves.
- 210.6 Any member with documented and certified training according to department standards and a favorable letter of recommendation from a previous Chief, may be eligible to have six (6) months of their probationary period waived.
