PURPOSE: The purpose of this standard is to define the apparatus response order for the department.

SCOPE: All department members are to adhere to this standard.

ENFORCEMENT: The Chief or OIC shall be responsible to enforce this standard.

APPLICATION:

A. Apparatus Response Emergency Run

The following apparatus shall respond to the type of runs listed without request from OIC:

EMS/Medical	787
Motor Vehicle Accident	781 & 782
Vehicle Fires	781 & 785
Field/Grass Fires	784, 785 & 787
Structure Fires	781, 785, 782
Haz-mat	782
Power Lines/Investigation (w/o structure involvement)	781
Weather Watch	782, 785

Additional apparatus shall not respond unless requested by the OIC. At such time the OIC shall notify all station personnel of apparatus requested and mode of response.

B. Apparatus Response Non-Emergency Run

Non-Emergency shall be defined as "situation where there is no apparent threat to life or substantial property value"

All apparatus on these runs shall respond to normal traffic obeying all speed limits and traffic signals.

C. Apparatus Response Mutual Aid

Only the apparatus requested by the requesting department shall respond to the scene.
