SUBJECT: End of Run Procedures

PURPOSE: The intent of this standard is to define the duties of all personnel in returning equipment to a serviceable condition.

SCOPE: This standard applies to all personnel who respond to an emergency incident, or participates in a training exercise where equipment is used and needs to be returned to a serviceable condition.

ENFORCEMENT: Adherence to this standard shall rest with the Officer in Charge.

DEFINITIONS:

Action evaluation – otherwise known as a Post Mortem, is a review and critic of the events leading up to, during, and after the incident is terminated.

APPLICATION:

416.1

All personnel at the scene shall assist in returning equipment back to the proper vehicle. The driver is responsible to see that all equipment is returned to the truck prior to leaving the scene.

416.2

All members shall return to the station to assist in returning equipment/apparatus to an in service, ready condition.

416.3

Any equipment problems or malfunctions are to be reported to the Officer in Charge upon returning to the station.

416.4

Equipment/apparatus used during the run are to be refueled, cleaned and replaced in a ready condition.

416.5

A member shall not leave the station/scene until properly released by the Officer in Charge.

416.6

An action evaluation may be conducted after the run at the discretion of the Officer in Charge.
