PURPOSE: this Incident Command System procedure is established to:

1. Provide for the safety of personnel operating at emergency incidents through improved command, control, and management of emergencies to which this department responds.
2. Improve the use of resources and tactical effectiveness.
3. Comply in part with the OSHA/EPA regulations requiring the use of an Incident Command System for Hazardous Materials Incidents.
4. Comply in part with NFPA 1500 requirements for the use of an Incident Command System for operations at all emergency incidents.

SCOPE: The Central Joint Fire District shall implement the Incident Command System appropriately at all incidents.
